## Animal License Renewal Reminder

We kindly remind all pet owners to renew their pet licenses for the year. Licensing helps keep our pets safe and supports a responsible, caring community.

Responsible Pet Ownership Bylaw is available on the Village website. It outlines our shared responsibilities as pet owners and helps ensure a safe and welcoming community for everyone.

Annual License Fees  
(until January 31):

Unaltered dog or cat: \$20

Altered dog or cat: \$10

*Penalty for not licensing  
your pet: \$75*

## Important Notice

### Winter Sidewalk Snow & Removal Effective January 1, 2026

All property owners in the Village are responsible for clearing snow, ice and other obstructions from sidewalks adjacent to their property.

All sidewalks must be cleared within 48 hours after a snow or ice event.

If you are unable to clear your sidewalk, arrange for a friend, family member, neighbour, or local contractor to do it on your behalf.

### Assistance for Seniors & Eligible Residents

Seniors (65+) or residents with limited mobility may qualify for financial help through Alberta's Special Needs Assistance for Seniors Program.

Helps Cover the costs of snow removal by a qualified provider.

## Business License Renewal Reminder

We kindly remind all business owners that a valid Business License is required to operate within the Village, as outlined in the Business License Bylaw.

### Annual Business License Fees:

Home-Based Business: **\$25**

Resident Business: **\$50**

District Resident Business: **\$75**

Non-Resident Business: **\$100**

Hawker/Peddler: **\$100 per day**

*Operating a business  
without a valid license may  
result in a \$200 penalty.*

## WATER RATE INCREASE

Effective January 1, 2026
