New Office Hours

To better serve residents and improve accessibility, Council has approved expanded office hours.

New Paper Copy Fee for Utility Invoices

Effective June 1, 2026, a new fee will be applied to all utility invoices that are mailed as paper copies. This fee is being introduced to help offset the rising costs associated with printing and mailing, including paper, envelopes, ink, and postage. Residents who prefer not to incur this fee are encouraged to switch to electronic billing, which is a convenient and environmentally friendly option.

Signing up is as simple as emailing admin@myrnam.ca or calling the Village Office.

An exemption will be available for residents who do not have access to electronic billing. If you believe you qualify, please contact the office to let us know.
