2026 Combined Assessment and Tax Notice

Please be advised that the 2026 Combined Assessment and Tax Notices have been mailed to all property owners in the Village of Myrnam on Friday, May 15, 2026. In accordance with Section 311 of the *Municipal Government Act*, Chapter M-26, RSA 2000, all assessed persons are deemed to have received their notices by way of this public notice.

If you disagree with your property's assessed value, you are encouraged to first contact the Chief Administrative Officer to verify its accuracy. If concerns remain, you may then contact the Village Assessor, Larry James of Wainwright Assessment Ltd., at 780-842-5002.

Should you wish to file a formal complaint with the Assessment Review Board, you must submit your written complaint no later than Wednesday, July 22, 2026, to:

Complaints must be submitted using the Assessment Review Complaint Form (LGS1402), available at the Village Office or online at: <https://www.alberta.ca/property-assessment-complaints-and-appeals.aspx>

Each complaint must be accompanied by the applicable fee: \$50 for Residential properties or \$100 for Non-Residential. Incomplete forms, late submissions, or complaints submitted without the appropriate fee will be deemed invalid.

Please note: Property taxes for 2026 are due and payable on or before July 31, 2026.

This new service will be managed by Circular Materials, a national not-for-profit, responsible for Alberta's transition to Extended Producer Responsibility (EPR) for packaging and paper products.

Soon, you'll be able to recycle materials like glass, foam packaging, flexible and rigid plastic packaging, cardboard, paper and metal containers and packaging in your curbside recycling program and at your local depot.

ACCEPTED ITEMS



BULK RUBBISH

- Trees, shrubs, stumps
- Scrap lumber & scrap metal
- Large boxes & crates
- Oil drums & similar large materials
- Discarded furniture & fixtures
- Mattresses, tables, fences & gates
- Water tanks, stoves, furnaces, and more



DOMESTIC GARBAGE

- Tin cans, broken glass, bottles
- Food containers, dishes & utensils
- Clothing, rags, papers, books & magazines
- Packing materials & cartons
- Grass clippings, weeds, leaves & garden waste



JUNK

- Engine blocks & machinery parts
- Tires, vehicle bodies & components
- Metal, glass & similar discarded materials



NO INDUSTRIAL OR HAZARDOUS WASTE



There will still be regular weekly garbage pick up on **Thursday, June 4th.**

PLEASE PREPARE ITEMS FOR COLLECTION AS FOLLOWS:



Garbage shall be thoroughly drained of all liquid and shall be securely contained in sealed plastic garbage bags before its disposal into a Garbage Receptacle or Bin.



Ashes shall be extinguished so that no fire remains and bagged before being placed in a Garbage Receptacle or Bin.



Combustible garbage shall be placed in containers carefully secured and prepared for collection as follows:

- (a) Clippings from shrubs and trees shall be compactly and securely tied in bundles not exceeding three feet (one meter) in length.
- (b) Discarded clothing and fabric, newspapers, wastepaper, magazines, and similar dry inoffensive garbage shall be enclosed in cardboard boxes or other containers and securely tied.

- (c) Cardboard boxes and similar crating and shipping containers shall be collapsed and securely tied into compact bundles.
- (d) Shredded packing materials, shavings and trimmings from lawns and gardens shall be securely baled and wrapped in heavy paper or packed in cardboard boxes, burlap or plastic bags and securely tied.
