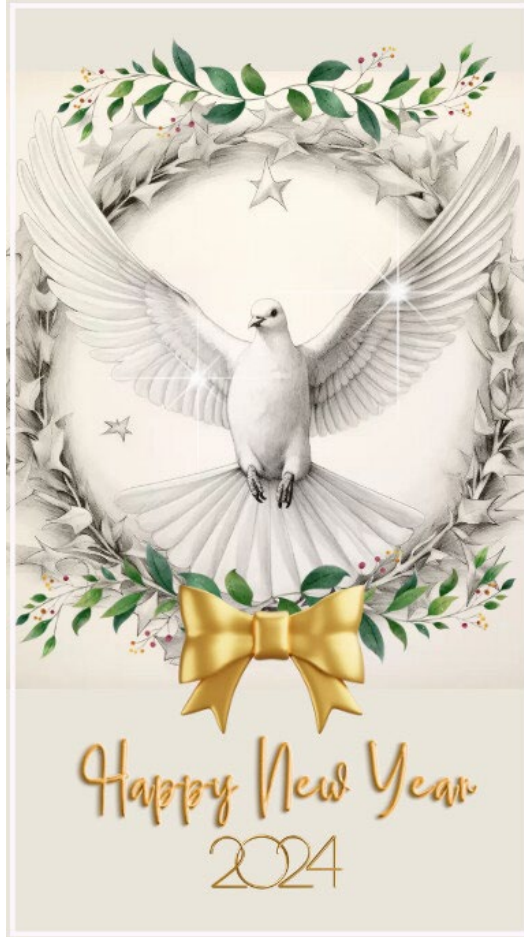
Business License Renewal Reminder

Home-based Business \$25
Resident Business \$50
District Resident Business \$75
Non-Resident Business \$100
Hawker/Peddler \$100/day

*Operating a business without a business license \$200

We are encouraging all pet owners to please read Bylaw 2018-07 and to license your pets, not only to acknowledge the responsibilities of being a pet owner within our Village but to keep your pets and our community safe as well. Bylaw is available on our website.

Annual License Fee (up to January 31st):

Unaltered Dog or Cat \$20
Altered Dog or Cat \$10

*Annual license fees are doubled after January 31st.

*Penalty for not getting a license \$75
