Spring Cleanup!!

Monday June 2, 2022

The Village is sponsoring a cleanup day to provide for the removal of all junk, garbage, rubbish, litter, waste and all other related material from the Village.

Village staff, council, and volunteers will be picking up old appliances, tree/shrub clippings, grass/garden waste on Friday, June 2th.

Clippings from trees and shrubs are compactly and securely tied in bundles not exceeding 3 feet in length.

Shredded packing materials, shavings and trimmings from lawns and gardens shall be securely baled and wrapped in heavy paper or packed in cardboard boxes, burlap or plastic bags, and securely tied,

Cardboard boxes and similar crating and shipping containers shall be collapsed and securely tied into compact bundles.

Appliances

All other items should be enclosed in cardboard boxes or other container and securely tied.

Please place above items to be picked up in a convenient, easily visible and accessible location close to the alley or garbage receptacle.

Primary responsibilities will be park, green spaces, and planter maintenance which include planting, maintaining, and watering edible and flowering plants, grass cutting and weed control.
