



**BYLAW NO. 2026-04  
OF THE  
VILLAGE OF MYRNAM**

**A BYLAW OF THE VILLAGE OF MYRNAM, IN THE PROVINCE OF ALBERTA,  
TO IMPOSE FEES FOR ISSUING PERMITS FOR OVERWEIGHT AND OVER-  
DIMENSIONAL COMMERCIAL VEHICLES ON HIGHWAYS UNDER THE DIRECTION,  
CONTROL AND MANAGEMENT OF THE VILLAGE OF MYRNAM**

**WHEREAS** the Province of Alberta has enacted Alberta Regulation 315/2002, the Commercial Vehicle Dimension and Weight Regulation for the purpose of restricting the weight and size of vehicles or of vehicles and the goods being carried by the vehicles operating on highways; and

**WHEREAS** the Province of Alberta has developed the Transportation Routing and Vehicle Information System - Multi Jurisdiction (TRAVIS-MJ) to address industry's need for a simplified, electronic oversize commercial vehicle permitting system.

**WHEREAS** TRAVIS-MJ has the ability to charge permit applicants a fee set by the municipality for services provided the municipality; and

**WHEREAS** the fee collected by the Province on behalf of the municipality will be distributed to the municipality to ensure that the municipality does not incur any cost in adopting TRAVIS-MJ.

**NOW THEREFORE** the Council of the Village of Myrnam, in the Province of Alberta, enacts as follows:

**1. Title**

1.1 This Bylaw may be referred to as the "TRAVIS-MJ Bylaw".

**2. Definitions**

2.1 In this Bylaw, words have the meanings set out in the Act, except that:

(a) "**Municipality**" means the Village of Myrnam in the Province of Alberta.

**3. Application**

3.1 The Village may provide Garbage collection services in accordance with a collection Schedule established by the Manager, to Premises within the Village.

**4. Duties and Obligations**

4.1 That an Overweight / Oversize vehicle permit fee, as set by Council, is charged to the applicants for the issuance of permits for overweight and oversize vehicles or of vehicles and the goods being carried by the vehicles to operate on highways under the direction, control, and management of the Municipality and such fee shall be set in the Municipality *Master Rates Bylaw*.

4.2 The Municipality hereby delegates to the Province of Alberta, through TRAVIS-MJ, the ability to charge permit applicants a fee as set by the Municipality.

**5. General**

5.1 Every provision of this Bylaw is independent, and if any provision declared invalid by a Court of competent jurisdiction, all other provisions shall remain valid and enforceable.

5.2 This Bylaw comes into full force and effect upon third reading.
